

1 Yes, these appear to be items 14-A and B. I  
2 do have a written description of the other six  
3 cartridges in my report. However I performed no  
4 detailed examinations of them.

5 Q. I see.

6 And does that include Number 7 as well which  
7 in your report is referred to as E-7?

8 A. E-7 I did examine in some detail. The other  
9 one that I didn't examine is State's Exhibit No. 13.

10 Q. All right. Can you tell us just how you  
11 conducted your examination, how you went about it,  
12 what you did and what conclusions you came to?

13 A. Yes, I can. I conducted my examinations on  
14 June 27 and 28, 1983. I worked with Criminalist Jim  
15 Pex. I received the exhibits from him.

16 As I did so, I made a rather detailed series  
17 of notes wherein I recorded the way the items were  
18 packaged. I wrote down a physical description of the  
19 packaging materials and also the objects contained  
20 within.

21 I subsequently issued a report which  
22 describes the items themselves but not the packaging  
23 material.

24 I examined all of these exhibits using a  
25 stereobinocular microscope with some magnification so
